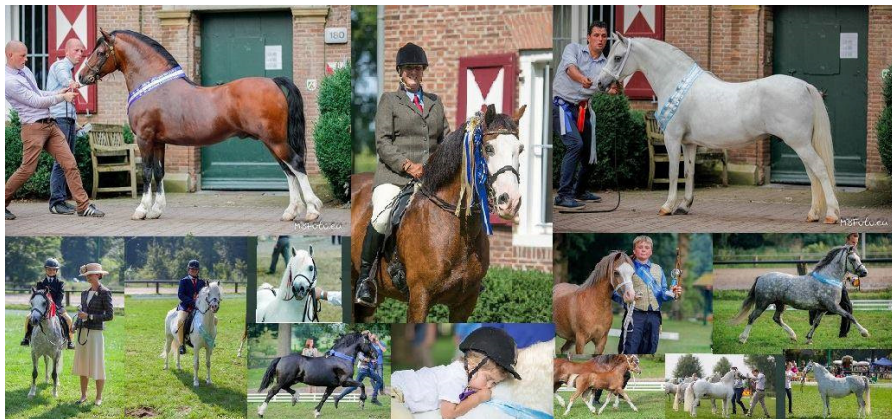
At the International Welsh Show Hamaland we have, besides breeding classes in Hand for Welsh ponies of all sections and for Part-Breds, a number of performance classes both ridden and in harness. Also we encourage the showing of Geldings, Veterans and hold a special championship for the youngest members of the Welsh pony world, a Mini Championship.

New for this year are the in Hand and Ridden classes for the British native breeds (including Connemara), together with NRPS and DRP. We have been asked to add some classes for them to our show, so we did and hope we will get good entries.

To turn this show into a day to remember for all involved, we as International Welsh Show Hamaland Group hope all competitors of last year, and a lot of new people will find their way to our show and enter their ponies in one of our classes. 1. Only Welsh ponies and Part Breds (minimum 12,5% Welsh Blood) registered with an European approved Society can enter at the show. They will also need to have a passport and have to be chipped according to the rules of the home country. Foals that have been weaned have to have their passport already and have to be chipped according to countries rules. For the non welsh classes all UK Native breeds are welcome, together with Connemara, NRPS and DRP registered ponies.
2. Every entered pony needs to have insurance or the insurance of the owner needs to cover any damage caused at the show.
3. Entries can be done by post, email or through website and must be accompanied by the entry form and pedigree. Please also state the class number(s) on the pedigree of the pony.
4. Stallions 4 year and over need to be licensed with an European approved Society.
5. Foals have to be at least 3 weeks old and have to be shown on the lead in both their class and the class the dam is entered in.
6. 3 year old fillies with foals at foot are not allowed to compete.
7. Colts 2 years and over need to be shown bitted. Mares are not to be shown in Stallion Bit
8. Only entered ponies are allowed to compete in the classes. No entries on the day will be accepted.
9. Ponies can only compete in the classes they are entered in. In case there was a mistake with the entry, mention this at the Show Secretary when collecting the numbers.
10. Only one handler per pony is allowed in the showing. A whip with a maximum length of 75 cm can be used.
11. No stallions or broodmares allowed in „Junior Handling“, „Lead Rein“ and „First Ridden“.
12. Riders competing in Leading Rein or first ridden can not compete in other riding classes. Ponies can compete in multiple classes as long as the rider is different.
13. In all riding classes an approved hard hat is mandatory (at least 3-Point Hats), no side reins are allowed. In the „Lead Rein“ and „First Ridden“ no spores and in Lead Rein also no whip are allowed. In First ridden only a short whip may be used.
14. The maximum height for Lead Rein and First Ridden is 1.37m
15. Competing ponies can be shown with normal shoes. Heavy shoes are not allowed.
16. Everybody competes at their own risk, The Show Organisers are not responsible for Theft, lost items or damage to people or goods.
17. Except for Partbreds Manes and Tail can not be braided. One plait behind the ears is allowed.
18. By sending in the entry form, the competitor is obliged to pay the entry fee. This also includes ponies which are not shown on the day itself.
19. Ponies bred, owned, leased or in the current or previous showseason shown by the Judge are not allowed to be entered.
20. For safetyreasons it is not allowed to operate any cooking device or have open fire at the Parking.
